James Gordon is the founder of Canada's premier folk group TAMARACK. With this durable trio he toured every corner of the continent, recorded fourteen albums, and made countless television and radio appearances. He is well-known for his original songs about Canada's identity and heritage. He was a regular songwriting contributor to the CBC radio programs. He has also released numerous solo albums for adults and children, composed works for symphony orchestras, and written music for theatre, dance and film. His original folk opera "Hardscrabble Road" debuted in 2003. His song "Frobisher Bay" was named "Favourite Canadian Song" in the roots category in a national CBC radio contest.
